### Observation questions

3. What happened to Saul after Ananias prayed for him?
4. What does it mean to “quench the Spirit”?

### Interpretation questions

1. What does Acts 1:8 teach about the purpose of the Holy Spirit?
2. Why is it dangerous to focus on spiritual gifts while neglecting spiritual fruit?
3. Why does true revival require repentance and transformed living?
4. Why do believers need both clarity and courage?
5. How can fear prevent Christians from reaching people who are different from them?
6. Why is dependence on the Holy Spirit meant to be daily, not occasional?
7. Why is the Holy Spirit meant to help believers not only in church but also in wilderness seasons?

6. Who in your life might God be asking you to reach or love more intentionally?
7. What fears keep you from being bold about your faith?
8. How can your daily life become a witness for Jesus at work, school, or home?
9. Is there an area where God has already given you clarity, but you still need courage to obey?
