2. What does biblical peace look like during difficult seasons?
3. Which of the four qualities (Bold, Agile, Ready, Stable) is most challenging for you?
4. How does understanding the gospel give us confidence in spiritual warfare?
5. Why is sharing your testimony such a powerful tool?
