Observation questions

1. What was Jehoshaphat's initial response when he heard about the approaching armies?
2. Why do you think fear caused the people to seek God?
3. According to the message, what is the difference between being a worshipper and being a spectator?
4. What different forms of worship did the sermon identify?

Interpretation questions

1. How did worship change Jehoshaphat's perspective before the circumstances changed?
2. How does worship give us a greater revelation of who God is?
3. Why can a greater revelation of God lead to repentance?
4. How does worship deepen our relationship with God?
5. What does it mean that "worship grows with desperation"?

WORSHIP IS WARFARE

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Application questions

1. What am I currently facing that has caused me to worry more than worship?
2. What situation in my life am I trying to control that I need to surrender to God?
3. When I'm overwhelmed, what is usually my first response: worry, complaining, strategizing, withdrawing, or worship?
4. Is there something I need to repent of because God has revealed something about my heart?
5. Where do I need God to bring revival, within me, my relationships, my family, or another area of my life?
6. What currently has my attention more than God?
7. Am I magnifying my circumstances or magnifying God?
8. What does my current worship reveal about my relationship with God?
