Observation questions

Interpretation questions

1. Why is recognizing a thought different from believing a thought?
2. Why is it important that the sword is used against spiritual forces rather than people?
3. What is the difference between testing God and trusting God?
4. What does the phrase "the crown has to come through the cross" mean to you?

Application questions

1. What lie have you been believing that God wants you to replace with truth?
2. What thought pattern do you need to stop rehearsing?

5. Are you currently in a wilderness season? If so, what would it look like to keep walking instead of quitting?
6. Where are you more concerned with being seen than being faithful?
7. What is one practical change you can make this week?
